# Foundation Seminar (FN121, 3 credits)

# **Course Description:**

As part of the DCAD first year experience, this innovative course provides an introduction to skills required for the composing of art and self-promotion. Area Coordinators teach seven different units emphasizing artist communication skills, and quantitative literacy in rendering dynamic compositions, documenting their studio examples, writing about that work, speaking about art and creating a digital portfolio. The course also prepares students with skills needed to participate in the first year portfolio review in the spring semester.

Prerequisite: None

#### Students will:

- 1. Demonstrate how sequential still images played rapidly in sequence create an illusion of motion. (PC 1, 2, 3)
- 2. Apply the visual concept of scale through the use of the viewfinder, grid, and ratios. (PC 1, 2, 3)
- 3. Explore an idea from conceptual thumbnails to tight sketches to finished art. (PC 1, 2, 3)
- 4. Produce a written statement that includes art related research and MLA style documented bibliography. (PC 1, 2, 3)
- 5. Create a multi-page PDF from layout software to understand basic framing compositions as a means to present their work in a consistent multiple of 4-8 portfolio pages. (PC 1, 2)
- 6. Utilize JPEGS and PDF images to create electronic portfolios. (PC 1, 2, 3)
- 7. Demonstrate knowledge of the essential elements of Oral Communication by developing and delivering an oral presentation on a topic relevant to the study of art and design. (Foundation Year PC 1, 2, 3; Liberal Arts PC 1, 4, 6)
